Create a new look

Collecting JustRite Stamps and Stampers will allow you to become your own stamp designer. Mix and match borders and centers from sets of the same size to create your own images. Use our font and unique interlocking grid system to create your own custom messages in the center of the stamper or on the rim of the stamper. This sample uses a center from *Loving Thoughts* (pg 4) and a border from *Just A Note* (November Release) on a 1 5/8" stamper in images 1 & 2. For image 3 we used a 2" stamper and created a custom message using our 15 pt. font on the outer rim.



Interchange borders and centers to create your own unique designs. Use our 2" stamper to combine 2" Round Decorative Borders with your 1 5/8" centers to create a fresh new look. The design possibilities are endless and our unique stamping system allows you to create your own sense of style. JustRite font gives you the ability to design the perfect sentiment for all your projects. Collect several sets and you multiply your design possibilities.



Let us jump start your creativity in designing a custom border with one of our demi phrase stamp sets. Simply stated, we have started the thought; you can use our 15 pt. font to finish the thought.

The 2" Round Stamper has a double grooved border on the stamper enabling use of 6 pt. or 15 pt. font in either groove to personalize your message or for monogramming. The second groove accepts borders of two different sizes. Use two decorative borders or combine it with font.

Font Centering Tip: Before placing your font on the rim, write the message you are creating on a scrap piece of paper. Divide the phrase into what you want on the top rim of the stamper and what will be on the bottom rim of the stamper. Count all the letters, characters and blank spaces for each section of the stamper. Divide the total number in half to determine the exact center of your phrase. Place these letters in the center of the bottom and top of the rim. Now complete the rest of your sentiment by placing the additional letters in your sentiment to the right or left of the center letter. To adjust the spacing of your sentiment use your tweezers to slide the font in the border.
